LEARN THE BEST WAY TO WORSHIP AND SACRIFICE

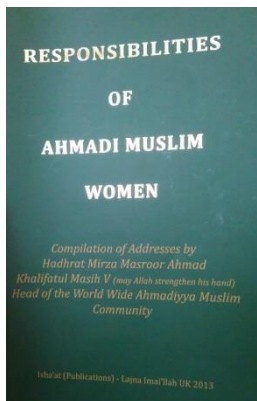
