Allah prefers those who hasten to be the first to greet others.

Allah tells us to try and be better than each other in doing good deeds. If we try to be first in doing anything good, Allah will be pleased with us. So if a Muslim always tries to be the first to say Assalamu alaikum ('May peace be with you), he will gain Allah's pleasure.

If you ever have an argument always be the first to say salaam. Salaam overcomes barriers, heals rifts and strengthens friendships.
