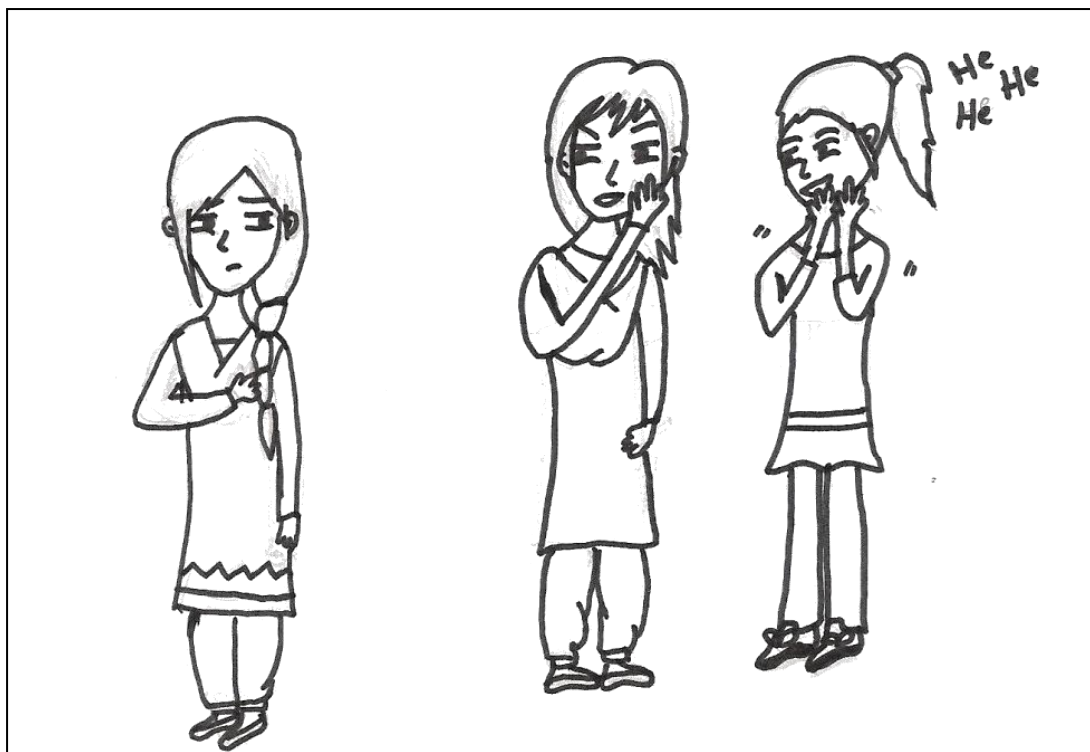


Hadith : Against Backbiting
