







The Holy Qur'an	The sacred text of Islam - the revelations of God to Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) through the angel Gabriel. The word Qur'an means that which is often read or recited.
Hadith	Words actually spoken by the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) or words that describe an incident related to his life.
The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him).	Messenger of God. The Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) came to show the right path to the whole world under the name of Islam, through the beautiful teachings of the Holy Qur'an.
The Promised Messiah (on whom be peace)	Hadhrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (on whom be peace). The Promised Messiah and Imam Al-Mahdi. Founder of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.
Successor	One that succeeds another.
Hadhrat Al-Haaj Maulana Hakeem Nooruddin (may Allah be pleased with him)	Khalifatul Masih I (Khalifatul Masih Uvval) First Successor to the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace). Period of Khilafat: 1908-1914
Hadhrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmood Ahmad (may Allah be pleased with him)	Hadhrat Musleh Maud Khalifatul Masih II (Khalifatul Masih Thaani) Second Successor to the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace). Period of Khilafat: 1914 – 1965
Hadhrat Mirza Nasir Ahmad (may Allah have mercy on him)	Khalifatul Masih III (Khalifatul Masih Thaalith) Third Successor to the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace) Period of Khilafat: 1965-1982
Hadhrat Mirza Tahir Ahmad (may Allah have mercy on him)	Khalifatul Masih IV (Khalifatul Masih Raabi) Fourth Successor to the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace). Period of Khilafat: 1982 - 2003
Hadhrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (may Allah strengthen his hand)	Khalifatul Masih V (Khalifatul Masih al Khaamis) Fifth Successor to the Promised Messiah ^(as) Period of Khilafat began in 2003
Prophecy	The foretelling or prediction of what is to come. Something that is declared by a prophet
