

Rules and Regulations

Only first position holders from Regional Level will take part in National Nasirat ijtema. All Regions must submit names of Nasirat, one month before National ijtema.

Tilawat-e-Qur'an

- Every Nasira **MUST** recite their Tilawat with text in front of them so no possibility of error is made to Quranic text. Judges will deduct marks for rules not followed.
- Most points will be allocated for BASIC pronunciation and Tajweed.

English & Urdu Speech Competitions


Nasirat with guidance, should write their own speeches. Judges

will award points for speech content, delivery and their content to be easily understood by other children, relevant to their age group. **Memorisation is NOT compulsory.**

Speeches time limit:	
Age: 7-9	2 minutes
Age: 10-12	2 minutes
Age: 13-14	3 minutes

There will be a **leeway of 15 seconds** either way.So, no marks will be deducted if they go over or under 15 seconds.

Hifz-e-Nazm

Nasirat can select one nazm provided from their age group. All nazms selected are from Durre-Sameen, Kalame Mahmood, Kalame Tahir or Dure Adan. Verses may be repeated. Judges will mark for **voice, tune/control and pronunciation**. There is a time limit of **2 minutes** at which point the nasira will be allowed to complete the couplet she is reciting and then be stopped. **All Nazms MUST be memorised.**

Hifz-e-Qur'an

The judges for this competition must be approved by the local Sadr, and should be chosen on her correct recitation of the Holy Qur'an. Nasirat will receive majority of marks for memorisation and should not be judged too strictly on their pronunciation. If more than one judge is required, then they should all work on the same set criteria so that all Nasirat are judged fairly. It is also

permitted to invite judges from neighbouring Majalis if that is deemed more suitable by the Sadr. Hifz-e-Qur'an will only take place at Local and Regional level.

Age Categories

Age groups will be decided and stay the same according to how old a child is when their local ijtema takes place. Girls will stay in their age group for that competition if they go through to regional and national ijtemas, even if their age changes during that time, for example if a girl is nine years old when she takes part in her local Ijtema, but then turns 10 she will still compete in the 7-9 age category at regional and national level.
