

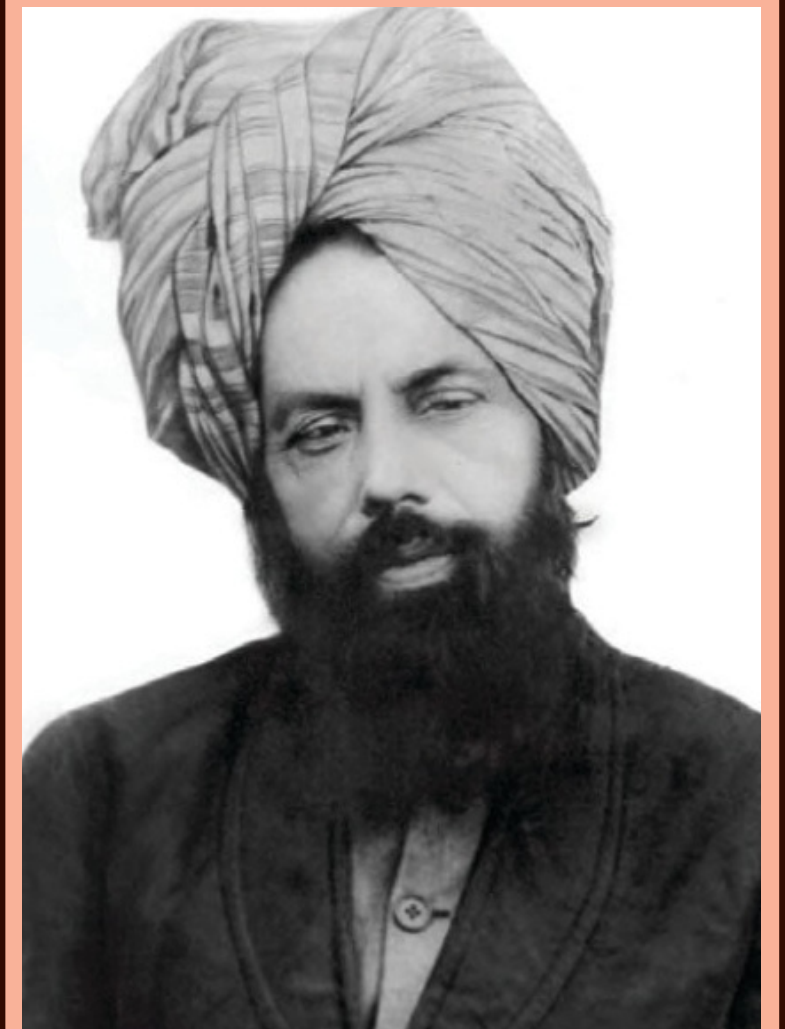


Quotes

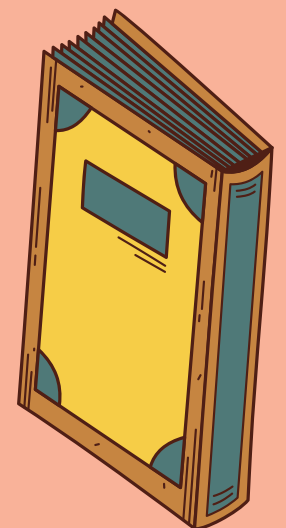
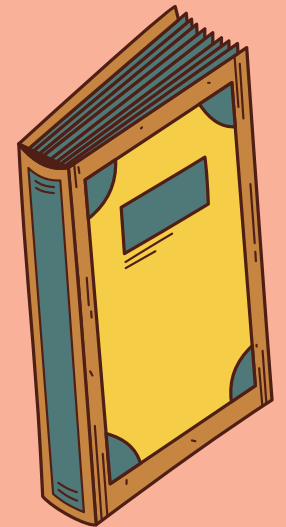
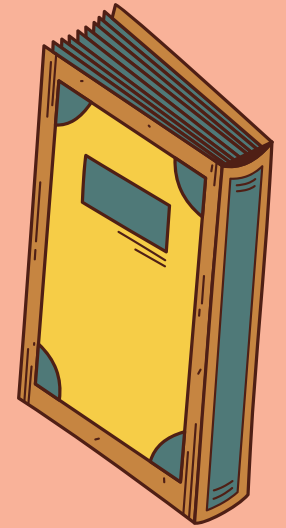
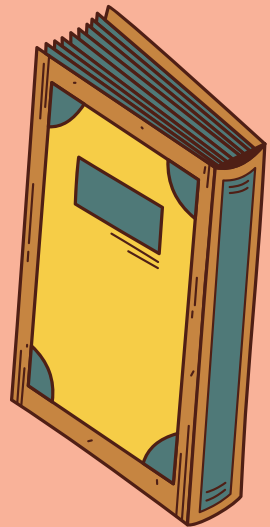




2) *God is the Central Beam of All Our Plans:*

Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad said:
