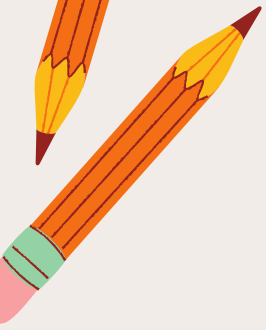




# Taleem: Education Activity
