Ijtema Rules

- **Dresscode** : This year we are introducing a uniform for **all** Nasirat at Ijtema of a modest **white long top** (Kameez or shirt) with regional colour dupatta. (Any colour bottoms/trousers may be worn)
- **Attendance** : Nasirat Ijtema is 3 days
Friday - 5pm- Maghrib & Isha
Saturday - 9.45am- 5pm
Sunday - 9.45am- 5pm
- **Supervision** : Please give **all** Nasirat the full name and phone number of a responsible adult who can be contacted if needed
 1. **7-9**: Should have a designated helper at all times
 2. **10-12** : Should be checked on by a known adult during the day
 3. **13-15** : Can be independant but should have a meet up point for the end of the day and contact info

- **Competitions:** For Tilawat, Speech and Nazm, those Nasirat who attained 1st position in Regional Ijtema will proceed to National Ijtema. If first place holder is unable to participate, then the 2nd place holder will be able to compete. Nasirat must arrive on time for their competitions to participate on the day

- **Tilawat Competiton:** Please note the following-

Girls who are menstruating should not participate in any competition involving lengthy recitations of the Holy Qur'an, such as Tilawat, Hifz e-Qur'an or Qur'anic prayers.

Second or third place holders should be prepared to step in if such a situation arises

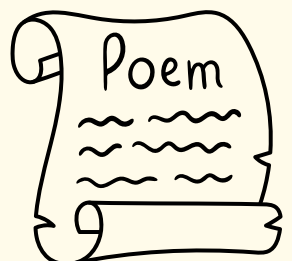
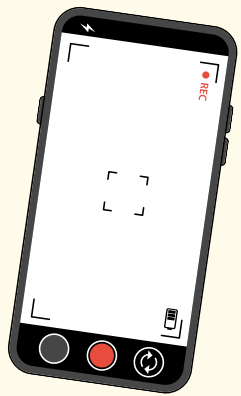

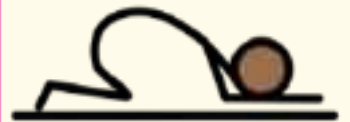

- 7-9 age gp - 10 lines maximum
- 10-12 age gp - 12 lines maximum
- 13-15 age gp - 12 lines maximum
- The poetry does not have to be memorised
- Marks are awarded for prose, content and delivery
- This is an open competition, ALL Nasirat can enter regardless of any other competitions they are participating in

Nasirat Ijtema Handicraft Syllabus 2026

Handicraft Competition Rules

- Nasirat are allowed to choose **one** handicraft item to make.
- Entries must be brought to the National Ijtema - Nasirat Gah on **Saturday 19th September by 11am** where judgement will take place.
- Please clearly label items with:
 1. Full Name of Nasirat
 2. Age of Nasirat (as well as age group for Ijtema this year)
 3. Majlis and Region
 4. Name and Contact telephone number of parent / carer

The items must be collected from Ijtema by Sunday 3pm or they will be disposed of



Option 1: Design a prayer mat on an A3 size fabric. The design can be any of your choice but must not have any arabic writing or any pictures of Huzoor (aba)



Option 2: On an A4 size paper, choose a mosque from around the world and design it. Include the name of the mosque and which country it is in. Design's can be made from whichever material you choose but must **not** be digital



Option 1: Choose a Hadith from your Journal and make a calligraphy piece. The calligraphy should be done on A4 paper and should include translation



Option 2: Make a fabric bag. The bag must have a strong handle, a zip and be strong enough to hold A4 sized books. You are free to design the front of the bag in any way you choose

Option 1: Sew a modest top, the top must be long sleeve and knee length. You are free to choose the colour and design as you wish



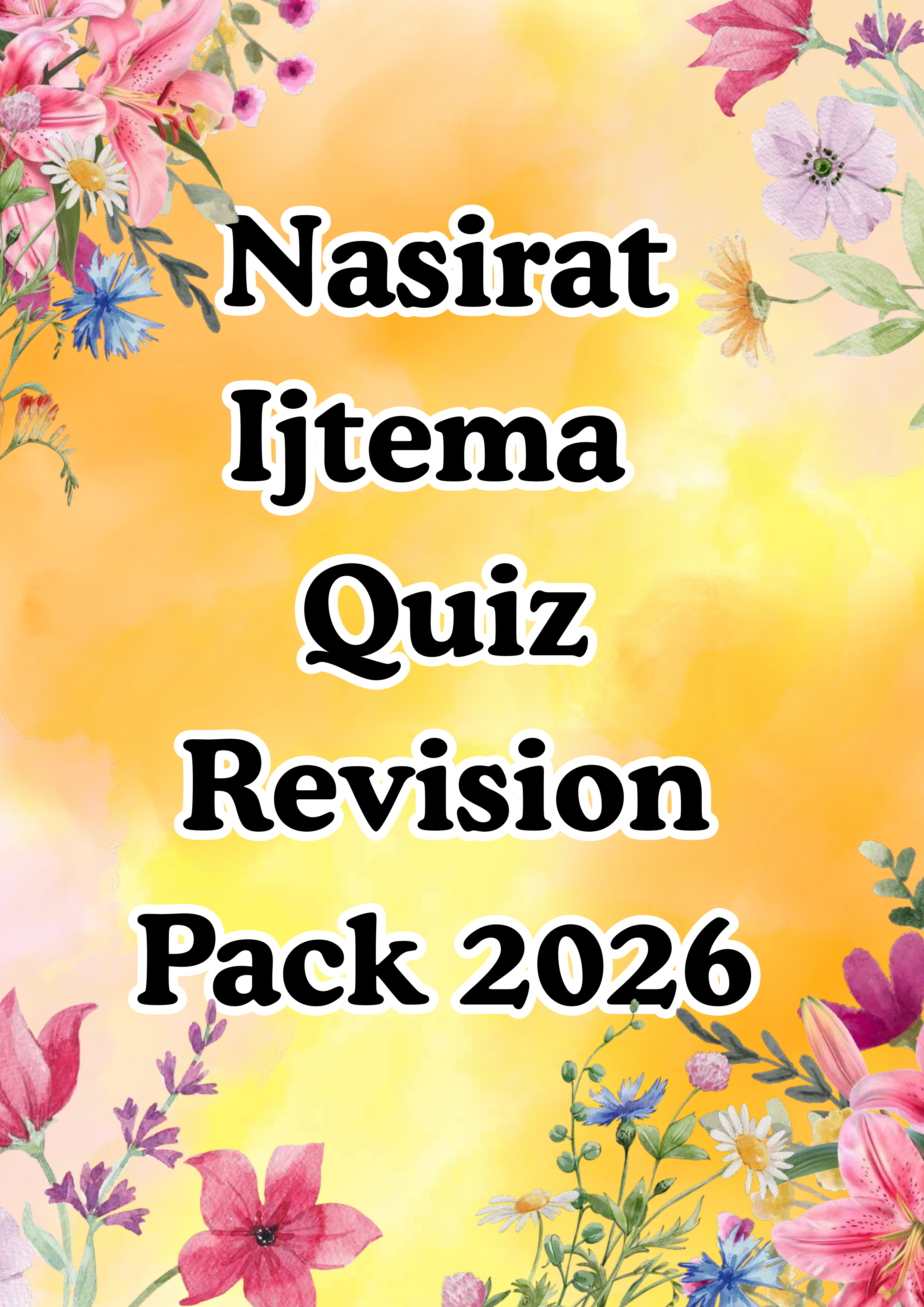
